Sunday 21 April 2024 – Fourth Sunday of Easter

Each year on the Fourth Sunday of Easter we deal with some image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd. This Sunday that passage comes from John 10 where Jesus actually refers to himself as the Good Shepherd. While this sounds nice, it is a statement that comes out of conflict with the religious leaders. In the previous chapter we hear how Jesus heals a man blind from birth and how the religious leaders reject this act of healing. Jesus responds by emphasising that not only has the man born blind received physical sight but also spiritual insight, while Jesus tells the powerful opponents that in their insistence that while they are able to see, they remain spiritually blind. Jesus goes on to talk about how the Good Shepherd must lay down his life, this is more than Jesus foretelling his death as Jesus says a Good Shepherd lays down their life in order to take it up. The role of the Good Shepherd is not to die, rather to provide protection, guidance and care. So what sort of shepherds are we?



HOLY COMMUNION ... YOU ARE INVITED TO JOIN US

Here at St Clement's the sacrament of Holy Communion, along with the Word of God, is central to our worship and an invitation to receive Holy Communion is extended to all who attend.

- Gluten Free If you require a gluten-free wafer at communion, please simply ask the priest during communion.
- Blessing If you wish to receive a blessing rather than communion, please indicate by keeping your hands by your side.
- Health and Safety If you have had a cold/virus over the past week we ask that you receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is the bread and not the wine. Taking the chalice is optional. Please note that intinction (dipping the bread) is not permitted as it is a health risk; it also introduces gluten to the wine, which is a further health risk to those who have a gluten allergy.
