## HOLY COMMUNION YOU ARE INVITED TO JOIN US

Here at St Clement's the sacrament of Holy Communion, along with the Word of God, is central to our worship. Please note that there will not be communion at our Good Friday service this year as we focus on the sacrament of God's Word. At all our other services this weekend we will have communion and an invitation to receive Holy Communion is extended to all who attend.

*Gluten Free - If you require a gluten-free wafer at communion, please simply ask the priest during communion.*

*Blessing - If you wish to receive a blessing rather than communion, please indicate by keeping your hands by your side.*

*Health and Safety - If you have had a cold/virus over the past week we ask that you receive Holy Communion in one kind; that is the bread and not the wine. Taking the chalice is optional. Please note that intinction (dipping the bread) is not permitted as it is a health risk; it also introduces gluten to the wine, which is a further health risk to those who have a gluten allergy.*
